Subject: BWA State Championships - Referee Rostering

At the 2019 Smarter than Smoking BWA State Championships, the Under 17 and Under 19 Divisions will be centrally rostered by Basketball WA.

This only applies to the Under 17s and 19s and **does not** apply to the Under 15s on the same weekend. Associations are required to supply and roster referees for all other grades outside of the Under 17s and 19s.

Basketball WA views the Under 17s and 19s as the key divisions vital for exposure of future SBL and SBL Division 1 referees. Associations will be required to put forward officials who are interested in developing further with the possibility of officiating SBL or SBL Division 1 in 2020 or 2021. If you are an official who would be interested in participating in this development opportunity and your association is not participating on this weekend please contact Jessica Byrnes via email.

Dates and requirements

- Basketball WA will require referee nominations from associations no later than **5pm Friday the 8th of November.**
- Associations are required to nominate one (1) official per two (2) teams that are nominated, with a minimum of one nomination required. (i.e 1 team 1 official, 2 teams 1 official, 3 teams 2 officials).
- A nominated official cannot be used to officiate other grades on the same weekend

Pays

There will be an additional referee fee added to each team nomination. This referee fee is \$125.00 for each team however no additional referee payment will be required for any U17 or U19s team.

Basketball WA will roster and pay Finals Referees for all grades each weekend as per the arrangement in 2018.
