The WABL competition shall be conducted under the playing rules of FIBA with modifications as outlined below or where applicable.

Team roster	12 players selected in any one game. Movement between teams is not permitted
Referee(s)	2x, 1x supplied and paid by each team
Time/Score keeper(s)	2x, 1x supplied by each team
Time-outs	1 per half
Game duration	3 minute warm-up U12s and U14s – 8 minute fully timed halves U16s and U18s – 10 minute fully timed halves 2 minute half time
Draws/Overtime	If scores are tied at the conclusion of a round robin game, the draw will stand. If scores are tied at the conclusion of a Cross Over game, there will be as many periods of 3 minutes of Overtime as necessary to break the tie.
Foul limit per team	7 team fouls, shoot on the 8 th
Foul limit per player	5 fouls

Tournament Notes:

- All players must be wearing mouthguards and correct association uniform. Players without mouthguards or correct uniform will not be permitted to take the court.
- Basketball at all levels is determined by head-to-head results before points percentage. While teams are expected to play hard, we strongly urge coaches to manage their margins and players.
